- Highly skilled in lighting as a design element and coordinating design intent with consultants.
- Expertise in reviewing shop drawings, submittals, samples to ensure drawings and finishes match construction documents.
- Skilled at fluently discussing methods of construction and correct uses of interiors and installation methods.
- Proven expertise in efficient space planning while incorporating building codes, accessibility codes, best practices, and current trends
- Must be comfortable working with budgets, work plan/hours estimate, project scheduling.
- Must be able to manage multiple concurrent projects in various design phases in a fast-paced environment and work collaboratively with team members.
